

The Marsabit Humanitarian Mission: 2024

Global Mission Outreach is an interdenominational organization founded in 2005, dedicated to fulfilling the great commission by reaching and empowering the church to reach the world. Under the leadership of Bishop Dr. Kennedy Mbatia, the organization has a strong commitment to addressing pressing humanitarian needs alongside the need of the gospel in various communities in Kenya by spreading hope and compassion through humanitarian efforts.

For this course, Global Outreach Missions will undertake a significant humanitarian mission in Korr, a remote area of Marsabit County, Kenya from 25th of November to 1st of December. Korr faces numerous challenges, including harsh climatic conditions, an arid landscape, and limited access to essential services such as clean water, healthcare, and education. The mission aims to address these critical issues and empower the local community through sustainable initiatives, enhancing their quality of life and promoting resilience.

The Marsabit humanitarian mission aims to make a significant impact on the local community through a series of carefully planned activities designed to address immediate needs and promote long-term sustainability. First, we look forward to feed 600 households by providing food baskets, each costing an average of 1,200 shillings. This initiative will ensure that families have access to essential nutrition, particularly during this time of scarcity.

In addition to food provision, access to clean water is a critical concern in Marsabit. To address this, we will drill a borehole, which will serve as a vital resource for the community, ensuring they have a reliable supply of safe drinking water. This project not only improves health outcomes but also reduces the burden of water collection, allowing residents to focus on other essential activities.

Recognizing the need for spiritual outreach and community support, we are constructing a missionary house and purchase a ministerial vehicle. This will facilitate better access to remote areas, enabling our team to engage more effectively with the community and provide ongoing support. The establishment of a new church in Gurnet will further strengthen the local Christian community, offering a place for worship, fellowship, and spiritual growth.

To ensure the continuity of faith-based initiatives, we will facilitate a new discipleship and mission training program. This program aims to empower local leaders and laypersons within the body of Christ, equipping them with the skills and knowledge needed for effective ministry and long-term community development.

Finally, we will set up a free medical camp that will provide essential medical care, health education, and preventive services. This camp will address immediate health needs and promote awareness of hygiene and wellness practices, contributing to the overall health of the community..

Through these activities, the Marsabit mission seeks not only to provide immediate relief but also to lay the groundwork for sustained development and community resilience, fostering a healthier, more vibrant community in Marsabit.

To achieve these impactful initiatives, we are organizing a dedicated team of 75 missionaries, including 25 medical personnel, who will not only share the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ but also actively engage in the various activities outlined above. This diverse team will bring together a wealth of skills and experience, ensuring that our mission is holistic in its approach—addressing both spiritual and physical needs within the community.

We recognize that such a noble assignment of the Kingdom requires collective effort and support. Therefore, we call upon each and every one of you to partake in this mission through partnership in giving. Your contributions will play a vital role in the success of these initiatives, enabling us to provide essential resources and services that will transform lives and strengthen the community of Marsabit.
